		Do we use a modern, professional-grade spam and malware filter? (The one built into Microsoft 365 or Google is good, but not enough.)
		Has every employee completed security awareness training in the last 12 months? Do they know how to spot and report a phishing email?
		Is our office network protected by a business-grade firewall, not just the "all-in-one" router from our internet porvider?
		Are all workstations, servers, and network devices set to automatically apply security patches and updates?
		Is centrally-managed antivirus/endpoint protection installed and active on <i>every</i> computer that accesses company data (including remote laptops)?
		Do we have a separate, isolated "Guest Wi-Fi" network for visitors, non- employees, and personal devices?
		Do we have a formal checklist to <i>immediately</i> revoke all access (email, software, network) for a departing employee?
